

Decision No. 30246.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad at Livingston, in the County of Merced, State of California.) Appl. No. 21463.

O R D E R

ORIGINAL

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway Route No. 4 (Road X-Mer-4-D) at separated grades under the track of Southern Pacific Company at Livingston, Merced County, at the location as shown by map (Exh. A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-135.9-B. Applicant shall bear construction expense, and shall bear maintenance expense of structure below base of bridge seats. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance expense above base of bridge seats. Applicant shall file with this Commission, within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to construction and maintenance of said crossing; and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. Clearances shall conform to G.O. No. 26-C.

Upon completion, Crossing No. B-136.0, about 750 feet south of the crossing authorized herein, shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
