BY THE COMMISSION:

OPINION AND ORDER

Applicants seek an order authorizing the transfer by  
C.L. Wosgaard and Paul Christiansen, doing business as the Santa  
Ynez Valley Feed Store, to Roeser & Sons of its warehouse business,  
equipment and property used in warehouse operation at Solvang.<sup>1</sup>  
The transfer is to be in accordance with an agreement, a copy of  
which is attached to the application. Under this agreement Roeser  
& Sons are leasing the building and premises on which said feed  
store is located at a rental of \$75.00 per month. As a part of  
this transaction Roeser & Sons agrees to purchase from C.L. Wosgaard  
all the stock of merchandise on hand and to acquire the good will of  
the business.

Applicant Roeser & Sons will continue to operate the ware-  
house as a public utility under rates, rules and regulations shown  
in Warehouse Tariff No. 2, C.R.C. No. 2. The proposed transfer will  
not result in any curtailment of service.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a  
public hearing is not necessary and that the transfer from C.L. Wosgaard

to Roeser & Sons should be authorized; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above entitled application be and it is hereby granted, subject to the following conditions:

1. The consideration to be paid for the property herein authorized to be transferred shall never be urged before this Commission or any other rate fixing body as a measure of value of said property for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
2. C.L. Wosgaard and Roeser & Sons shall within ten (10) days from the effective date of the order, join in a common supplement to the tariff on file with the Railroad Commission in the name of Santa Ynez Valley Feed Store, applicant C.L. Wosgaard on the one hand withdrawing and applicant Roeser & Sons on the other hand accepting and adopting the tariff as their own.
3. The rights and privileges herein authorized to be conveyed may not be sold, leased, transferred nor assigned, nor service thereunder discontinued, unless the written consent of the Railroad Commission to such sale, lease, transfer, assignment or discontinuance has first been secured.

The authority herein granted will become effective on the date hereof.
