It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Toby, Kern County, for more than two years, and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Toby, in Kern County; to eliminate said station name from its records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station.

Within thirty (30) days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify this Commission in writing. The authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
