OPINION AND ORDER

Liberty Acres Water Company, a corporation, asks for authority to transfer its public utility water system to the County of Los Angeles, joint applicant herein, for and on behalf of Los Angeles County Water Works District No. 22.

The application alleges that Liberty Acres Water Company, a corporation, is the sole owner of a public utility water system located within the boundaries of Los Angeles County Water Works District No. 22, which is now constructing a water distributing system that will supply domestic water service to all consumers heretofore receiving water from said Company. Investigation shows that applicant utility does not owe any consumers for refundable deposits, that the Water Works District was organized by the water users themselves to improve service conditions in Liberty Acres and vicinity and that the transfer may be granted without the necessity of a public hearing, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Liberty Acres Water Company, a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer its water system on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1937, to the County of Los Angeles for and on behalf of Los Angeles

County Water Works District No. 22, as said system is more particularly described in the application herein which is hereby made a part of this Order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Liberty Acres Water Company, a corporation, shall file with this Commission on or before the thirty-first day of December, 1937, a certified copy of the final instrument conveying the properties herein authorized to be transferred, together with a written statement showing the date upon which it relinquished control and possession thereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
