O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at the applicant's Station of Eastberne for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its Class "B" Station of Eastberne, County of San Bernardino, to eliminate said name from its station records and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Applicant is also authorized to abandon and remove its spur track, approximately 600 feet in length, located at said station and as more definitely described in the application. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
