O P I N I O N

Charles Kuppinger has applied for authority to abandon an operating right created by Decision No. 17884, dated January 12, 1927, on Application No. 12240, for the transportation of furniture, household goods, pianos, trunks, and like personal effects, between Lakeport and Clear Lake Resorts, on the one hand, and Ukiah, Hoiland, Cloverdale, Healdsburg, Santa Rosa, Petaluma, San Rafael, Sausalito, San Francisco, Alameda, Oakland, Berkeley, and Richmond, on the other hand.

As justification for the abandonment of the operation and the revocation of the rights therefor, applicant alleges that there is insufficient traffic to warrant the continuance of such operation. The annual report of applicant for the year 1936, on file with the Commission, discloses that no business of any nature was conducted under the certificated operation.

It does not appear that public interest will be adversely affected in authorizing the abandonment as requested by applicant. No public hearing appears to be necessary and the authority will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Charles Kuppinger is authorized to abandon the transportation of furniture, household goods, pianos,

trunks, and like personal effects, between Lakeport and Clear Lake Reports, on the one hand, and Ukiah, Hopland, Cloverdale, Healdsburg, Santa Rosa, Petaluma, San Rafael, Sausalito, San Francisco, Alameda, Oakland, Berkeley, and Richmond, on the other hand, as created by Decision No. 17884, dated January 12, 1927, on Application No. 12240, and

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 17884 is revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Charles Kuppinger shall immediately cancel all tariffs and time schedules now on file with this Commission in his name covering the service herein authorized to be abandoned.
