FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Commission's Order in Decision No. 30348 dated November 22, 1937, provides that the authority therein granted shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date thereof, provided San Gabriel Valley Water Service has paid the fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which fee is thirty-four (34) dollars. The Company has paid the fee and has advised the Commission that it does not desire to file a petition for rehearing. It also asks that the authority granted by said

order be made effective immediately. We have considered applicant's request and believe such request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph three (3) of the order in Decision No. 30348 dated November 22, 1937, reading:

"3. The authority herein granted shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof, provided San Gabriel Valley Water Service has paid the fee prescribed by Section 57 of the Public Utilities Act, which fee is Thirty-four (\$34) Dollars,"

be, and the same, is hereby amended so as to read:

The authority herein granted will be effective on the date hereof.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the order in Decision No. 30348 dated November 22, 1937, shall remain in full force and effect except as modified by this first supplemental order.
