O R D E R

ORIGINAL

It appears from the above application that no passenger business and only four carload shipments were handled at applicant's station of Fep for more than two years and that the continued maintenance thereof is unnecessary.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Fep, Santa Clara County, to remove station building and spur track, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying to said station. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
