

O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Shasta Retreat, Siskiyou County, for more than five years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Shasta Retreat, Siskiyou County, to abandon station buildings thereat, and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
