Request having been made by A. K. and J. F. Pierce that the parcel of land owned by them and located in Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 8 East, M.D.B. & M., comprising approximately thirty-five (35) acres, be included within the service area of The San Joaquin & Kings River Canal & Irrigation Company, Incorporated, a corporation, and that said land be entitled to irrigation service from the company's canals on the same basis as other lands admitted to service as set out in the Commission's Decision No. 29501, dated February 1, 1937, an investigation having been made in the matter, it being found that said land should be included within the company's service area and entitled to irrigation service, and written consent therefor having been obtained from the company, now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the parcel of land owned by A. K. and J. F. Pierce in Section 1, Township 9 South, Range 8 East,

M.D.B. & M., and containing thirty-five (35) acres, more or less, be and it is hereby included within the service area of The San Joaquin & Kings River Canal & Irrigation Company, Incorporated, a corporation, and said land shall be entitled to irrigation service from the company's canals on the same basis as those lands admitted to service as set out in the Commission's Decision No. 29501, dated February 1, 1937.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
