ORDER REVOKING CERTIFICATE

By Decision No. 15285, dated August 13, 1925, and
Decision No. 22947, dated October 7, 1930, on Applications Nos.
11562 and 16922, respectively, George W. Koenig, operating under
the name and style of Markleeville-Fredricksburg Stage Line, was
granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to con-
duct an automotive service as a common carrier of passengers and
freight between Markleeville, Woodfords and Fredericksburg as an
"on call" service seasonally from approximately October 1st to
June 15th of each year.

Under date of December 15, 1937, Mr. Koenig advised the
Commission in writing that he had not received any requests for
service over his line for the past two years and, therefore, it
appearing that there no longer existed any public demand for his
service, Mr. Koenig requests that his certificate be revoked.

In view of the circumstances set forth, we are of the opinion that the request of Mr. Hoening should be granted and his certificate of public convenience and necessity revoked and annulled.

WHEREFORE, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that George W. Hoening, operating under the name and style of Knoxville-Fredricksburg Stage Line, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all his common carrier automotive service for the transportation of passengers and freight between Knoxville, Woodford and Fredricksburg and the certificates of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted be and they are hereby annulled together with all tariffs and time schedules heretofore issued and filed therefor.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decisions Nos. 25265 and 22947 be and they are hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
