O R D E R

ORIGINAL

The Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across an unimproved portion of Cutting Boulevard and at grade across Third Street (unimproved) in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the locations described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be such that in the event Cutting Boulevard and Third Street are authorized to be improved, a crossing equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72 can be constructed.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
