Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Encinal Street in Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. L-77.6. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to that portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding eight per cent. Protoction shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing Signs. (G.O. NO. 75-A);

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
