ORDER VACATING ORDER OF SUSPENSION AND INVESTIGATION

By order dated March 15, 1937, and supplemental orders thereto, the Commission suspended until January 10, 1938, Item No. 300-D, Third Revised Page 18-A of Pacific Motor Transport Company's Local Express Tariff No. 12-A, C.R.C. No. 21, adding tobacco to the list of commodities to be rated as groceries and grocers' supplies, and thereby reducing the ratings and rates on tobacco between San Francisco and Santa Rosa and other points in California. The item was suspended following receipt of protests from a competing carrier alleging, among other things, that said proposed rates were unreasonably low and detrimental to its interest.

Subsequently, respondent informed the Commission that it desired to withdraw the suspended ratings and rates. Permission to do so was granted by the Commission¹ and the suspended schedule was cancelled effective January 6, 1938. The cause for the suspension has therefore been removed and our order of March 15, 1937, and supplemental orders thereto, should be vacated and this proceeding discontinued.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the order of March 15, 1937, and supplemental orders thereto in this proceeding suspending reduced ratings and rates on tobacco shown in Item No. 300-D on Third Revised Page 18-A of Pacific Motor Transport Company's Local Express Tariff No. 12-A, C.R.C. No. 21, be and they are hereby vacated and this proceeding discontinued.
