O R D E R

City of Huntington Park is authorized to construct Hampshire Drive at grade across one spur track connecting to San Pedro Branch of Southern Pacific Company at Huntington Park, Los Angeles Co., at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BG-487.55-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 39 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign. (G.O. 75-A).

Spur track marked "To be removed" on Exhibit A attached to application shall be removed insofar as it lies in Hampshire Drive.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
