BEFORE THE RAILROAD COLOCISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNI

In the matter of the application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway and the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad at Hewitt Station (Lankershim Blvd.) in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

ORDER

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway Route 159 (Road VII-LA-159-LA) locally known as Lankershim Blvd., at separated grades under the tracks of the Southern Pacific Railroad at Hewitt Station, Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-458.6-B. Applicant shall bear entire construction costs. Applicant shall file with this Commission within one hundred and twenty days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Company. In the event parties cannot agree with respect to apportionment of maintenance costs, the Commission will, by subsequent order, apportion such costs.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise this Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years (unless time be extended) or if conditions are not complied with. This order shall be effective immediately.
