BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

City of Huntington Park is authorized to construct Hampshire Drive at grade across three spur tracks off San Pedro Branch of Southern Pacific Company at Huntington Park, Los Angeles County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BG-428.04-C applying to that crossing referred to in application as approximately 950 feet south of the south line of Gage Avenue; Crossing No. BG-428.21-C, applying to that crossing referred to in application as approximately 1209 feet south of the south line of Gage Avenue; and Crossing No. BG-428.27-C, applying to that crossing referred to in application as approximately 2124 feet south of the south line of Gage Avenue. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than 39 feet and grades of approach not greater than 2 per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs at each of the three crossings (G.O. 75-A).

Prior to completion, spur track immediately south of Saturn Ave. shall be relocated, substantially as shown on map entitled

Exhibit "A" attached to the application. Applicant shall bear entire costs of such relocation in so far as spur lies within Hampshire Drive. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended) or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
