FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 29868 of June 14, 1937, in this proceeding, applicant was authorized to transport goods, wares and merchandise, under contract, for the Collector of Customs of the Treasury Department between points in the City and County of San Francisco for a period of six months from the effectiveness of said Decision No. 29868, at the rate of twenty-seven cents (27¢) per package.

By supplemental application filed January 13, 1938, it is alleged that the conditions relied upon to justify the original request are unchanged. Accordingly similar relief is sought for a further period of at least six months.

It appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the relief sought should be authorized;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said supplemental application be and it is hereby granted.

The authority herein granted shall expire six (6) months from the date hereof unless extended by order of the Commission.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
