O R D E R

ORIGINAL

It appears from the above application that one car of carload freight and seven shipments of less than carload freight have been handled at applicant's station of Wright, Santa Clara County, for the twelve months ending May 31, 1937; that the maintenance of station facilities is no longer necessary; and that said station should be changed from a Class "A" station to a Class "E" station. California Farm Bureau Federation has signified in writing that it has no objection to the granting of the application.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon and remove its passenger station, freight platform, and spur track at its station of Wright, Santa Clara County; to change said station from a Class "A" station to a Class "E" station; and to cancel all freight tariffs applying to said station. Within thirty days after abandonment applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended).

This order shall be effective immediately.
