O R D E R

It appears from the above application that passenger trains Nos. 187 and 188 operating on applicant's Santa Cruz Branch between Santa Cruz and Watsonville Junction do not earn sufficient revenue to defray the cost of their operation; and that applicant has an optional routing arrangement with Pacific Greyhound Lines, Inc., whereby tickets issued by applicant are honored upon the vehicles of that company between Santa Cruz and Watsonville Junction.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to discontinue the operation of passenger trains Nos. 187 and 188 on its Santa Cruz Branch between Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz County, and Watsonville Junction, Monterey County, California. Public shall be notified of said passenger train discontinuance for not less than five days prior thereto. Within thirty days after discontinuance, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
