ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By application filed October 29, 1937, Peter L. Tock, an individual engaged in the business of transporting property as a highway contract carrier, seeks authority to charge less than the minimum rates established by the Commission for the transportation of poultry feed and supplies from Petaluma to Anchor Bay and points within a radius of not to exceed five miles of Anchor Bay.

After due notice the proceeding was called for hearing at San Francisco before Examiner E. S. Williams. Coast Line Stages, Inc. and Sidney Johnson opposed the granting of the application, but no one appeared on behalf of applicant. Therefore, good cause appearing,
