

Decision No. 30607.

APPROVED

In the matter of the application of the County of Riverside, a body politic and corporate of the State of California, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing over the right of way of the Pacific Electric Railway Company for public highway purposes.

Application No. 21580.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The County of Riverside is authorized to construct Byron Street across the Riverside-Corona line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6W-11.54. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. 75-A).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
