BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 29947, dated July 12, 1937, authorized Indian Valley Railroad Company to abandon its line of railroad between Paxton and Crescent Mills, Plumas County, and to cancel all tariffs in conformity with the rules of this Commission. Applicant now requests that it be allowed to cancel its tariffs on less than statutory notice in order to conform with the tariff cancellation requirement of the Interstate Commerce Commission in its order in Finance Docket No. 11734, dated December 10, 1937.

Good Cause Appearing, Indian Valley Railroad Company is authorized to cancel rates, rules and regulations shown in tariffs applicable to that portion of the line authorized to be abandoned in Decision No. 29947, same to be effective not earlier than one day after filing with this Commission and posting at stations affected.

In all other respects said Decision No. 29947 shall remain in full force and effect.
