ORDER OF REVOCATION

The Commission having been advised in writing, under date of February 5, 1938, that the common carrier service referred to in the above entitled proceeding has been discontinued and abandoned, and there having been a further request therein for revocation of the certificate of public convenience and necessity under which the said service has been heretofore conducted,

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Emory E. Gilman, operating under the fictitious name and style of San Rafael Bus Service, as an automotive common carrier of passengers between San Rafael and Ross and intermediate points be and the same hereby is declared to have been discontinued and abandoned.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 13274, dated March 19, 1924, on Application No. 9873, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled, and all time schedules and tariffs therefor now on file with the Commission, are hereby cancelled.
