It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's non-agency station of Castro, Santa Clara County, for more than two years, and that the continued maintenance thereof as a non-agency freight station is no longer necessary.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change the non-agency station of Castro, Santa Clara County, from a Class D to a Class E station (freight will not be handled) and to amend the tariffs and time schedules applying there-to accordingly. Within thirty days after this change in classification, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This order shall be effective immediately.
