ORDER MODIFYING DECISION AND DENYING PETITION FOR REHEARING

Petition for rehearing or modification of Decision No. 30483 of January 3, 1938, in the above entitled proceeding, having been filed by John and Henry Nickols, copartners doing business as Nickols Transportation Company; the Commission having carefully considered the said petition and each and every allegation therein contained and being of the opinion that no good cause for the granting of a rehearing or for the modification of the order is therein made to appear, except as indicated in the first ordering paragraph herein,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the following paragraph be and it is hereby substituted for sub-paragraph 4 of the findings in said Decision No. 30483:

"Grain, in lots of not less than 80,000 pounds, from Stockton to Vallejo and San Francisco, and in lots of not less than 10,000 pounds between Stockton and Port Costa."

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said petition be and it is hereby denied.
