In the matter of the application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, a corporation, for authority to abandon its non-agency station of Wild, California, located on applicant's First District, Los Angeles Division, and to remove said station from applicant's time tables and tariffs; also to abandon that certain spur track installed to serve a lime deposit adjacent thereto.

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Wild for more than one year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Wild, County of San Bernardino; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Applicant is also authorized to abandon and remove its spur track at the non-agency station of Wild, as more particularly described in the application. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended.

This Order shall become effective immediately.
