The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway Route 23 (Road VII-IA-23-I) at separate grades over the track of Southern Pacific Company near Solamint, in Los Angeles County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit "A") attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-444.2-A.

Applicant shall bear construction and maintonance expense; and shall file with the Commission, within one hundred and twenty (120) days: (1) a copy of an agreement entered into between the parties relative to the construction and maintenance of said crossing, and (2) plans of said crossing approved by Southern Pacific Company. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-C. During construction only, side clearances of eight (8) feet, and overhead clearance of twenty-one (21) feet may be maintained, provided train speeds do not exceed twenty (20) miles por hour and train crows are notified by bulletin or train order of said impaired clearances.

Within thirty (30) days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two (2) years, unless time be extended, or if conditions

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are not complied with.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
