A. W. Schmitt, doing business as Livermore Valley Stages, herein seeks authority to discontinue and abandon his certificated common carrier operating right for the transportation of property as authorized and acquired between Livermore and Arroyo Sanitarium and intermediate points by Decision No. 18221, dated April 13, 1927, on Application No. 13635.

Applicant alleges that there is no demand for this service and has been none for the past fourteen (14) years. The passenger right of operator will be retained.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted in so far as it refers to the transportation of property.

QRDER

IT IS HEREEY ORDERED that A. W. Schmitt, doing business as Livermore Valley Stages, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all his service as a common carrier of property between Livermore and Arroyo Sanitarium and intermediate points and his ireight tariff therefor be and it is hereby cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 18221, dated April 13, 1927, be and the same hereby is revoked and cancelled in so far as it refers to the common carrier transportation of property. In all other respects Decision No. 18221 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
