In the Matter of the Application of County of Los Angeles for construction of crossing on Eastern Avenue over right of way of Pacific Electric Railway Company. } Application No. 21805

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Eastern Avenue across the Whittier line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6C-8.95. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of the outside rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than forty feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 4 (side-of-street installation) signal, and one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (C.O.75-A).

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
