O R D E R

It appears from the above application that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's non-agency station of McKay, San Luis Obispo County, for more than two years, and that the continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency Station of McKay, San Luis Obispo County; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station. Within thirty days after abandonment, applicant shall so notify this Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended.

This Order shall be effective immediately.
