


O R D E R

It appears from the above application that in view of lack of patronage, and the fact that there are other means of passenger transportation, the discontinuance of passenger service by applicant over that portion of its Kerman Branch, between Armona and Goshen Junction, will not be an inconvenience to the travelling public.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to discontinue passenger train service on that portion of its Kerman Branch between Armona, Kings County, and Goshen Junction, Tulare County, California, and to cancel all passenger tariffs and time schedules applying to stations affected on said line. Within thirty days after discontinuance, applicant shall so notify this Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one (1) year, unless time be extended. This order shall become effective immediately.
