OPINION AND ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

R. C. Adams and twenty-eight (28) other telephone subscribers of Pacific Beach exchange herein petition the Railroad Commission to authorize the Southern California Telephone Company to extend the base rate area of the Pacific Beach exchange.

The enlargement of this base rate area would result in the elimination of mileage charges to sixty-three (63) subscribers and the reduction of mileage charges to five (5) subscribers. One subscriber would be required to relinquish San Diego residence foreign exchange suburban ten-party line service, a type of service not permissible in a base rate area under the schedules of the utility. Various types of service and service arrangements are offered under the utility's tariffs which will meet the requirements of subscribers in the area proposed to be included in the Pacific Beach base rate area.

Southern California in its Answer and Tender of Satisfaction states that it is willing to extend the Pacific Beach exchange base rate area as requested and as shown on a map at-

tached to its Answer and Tender of Satisfaction as Exhibit "A," provided no rate irregularities or deviations are created.

The Commission has considered the request of the petitioners and the Answer and Tender of Satisfaction of Southern California Telephone Company and is of the opinion that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is required and that the relief sought should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Southern California Telephone Company shall extend its Pacific Beach exchange base rate area as shown on a map filed with its Answer and Tender of Satisfaction as Exhibit "A," effective on or before May 1, 1938 and subject to the condition that no rate irregularity or deviation shall be created thereby.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Telephone Company shall file with the Railroad Commission on or before five (5) days before the effective date of the base rate area extension a map showing the Pacific Beach exchange base rate area enlarged as shown on the map referred to above as Exhibit "A."

For all other purposes the effective date of this Order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
