In the matter of the application of the City of Newport Beach, a municipal corporation, for an order granting permission to construct a sidewalk crossing at 22nd Street, in the City of Newport Beach. ) Application No. 21632.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The City of Newport Beach is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at 22nd Street across the Newport Beach-Balboa line of Pacific Electric Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6E-37.81-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not more than ten feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by suitable warning signs of a type approved by this Commission. Such signs shall be erected and maintained by applicant.

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this Order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This Order shall be effective immediately.
