THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By its Decision No. 30393, dated December 13, 1937, issued on the above numbered application, the Commission granted an extension of time expiring April 20, 1938, for complying with conditions numbers 2 and 3 of Decision No. 30146 whereby 0. C. & N. Stages, Inc., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity involving rerouting of its service between Cornell, California, and the further authority to serve the town of Tule Lake, California.

Under date of Agril 8, 1938, O. C. & N. Stages, Inc., advised the Commission, in writing, that due to the fact that the Interstate Commerce Commission had not acted upon their interstate rights they would be unable, within the time limit now in force, to comply with the requirements referred to above and seek, therefore, a further extension of time from this Commission to comply with its order.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the time for complying with conditions numbers 2 and 3 of Decision No. 30146, as heretofore

extended to April 20, 1938, by Decision No. 30393, be and the same is hereby further extended from April 20, 1938 to and including October 1, 1938.

In all other respects Decision No. 30146 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
