<u>opinion</u>

By this application Ray O. Holloway seeks authority to discontinue his automotive service for the transportation of property as a highway common carrier between Porterville and Camp Nelson and intermediate points.

In justification of the granting of such authority, applicant alleges that the revenue derived from the transportation of freight between Porterville and Camp Nelson during the year 1937 was in the amount of \$1200 of which approximately \$850 was paid to applicant by the owner and proprietor of Camp Nelson Summer Resort; that for several years past approximately 70 per cent of all freight transported between the above named points was for the owner of Camp Nelson Summer Resort; that the resort was recently sold and its new owner, by a letter accompanying this application, advises that he intends to operate his own freight service between Porterville and Camp Nelson.

In view of those circumstances it appears that a public hearing in this matter is not necessary; the application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ray O. Holloway be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all his service as a

highway common carrier between Porterville and Camp Nelson and intermediate points and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 18072, dated March 14, 1927, on Application No. 13568, and all operative rights acquired thereunder are revoked and annualled.

For all other purposes the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
