ORDER

In this application the Board of Supervisors of the County of Kern, State of California, requests permission to make major alterations of the crossing at grade over the tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and designated as Crossing No. 2-895.2 (erroneously called Crossing No. 2-893.2 in the application).

A public hearing was held in this matter before Examiner Hall in Bakersfield on March 31, 1938.

At the hearing applicant made a motion to dismiss the application as it was its desire to proceed in this matter as a complaiment against the carrier involved. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company concurred in the motion.

The matter therefore will be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY CRDERED that Application No. 21243 is dismissed without prejudice.
