O R D E R

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct one spur track at grade across unimproved street reservation in Burlingame, San Mateo County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

This order is made upon the express condition that the unimproved street reservation is not now actually constructed and open to travel at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed an authorization for the construction of an opening of said street to public use across said spur track. Said track shall be so constructed that grades of approach not exceeding two (2) per cent will be feasible in the event that the construction of an opening of the street reservation across said spur track shall hereafter be authorized and so that said grade crossing may be made safe for the passage thereover of vehicles and other road traffic.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
