SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On May 9, 1938, Market Street Railway Company was authorized to make certain changes in its fare structure. (Decision No. 30849.) By supplemental application filed on May 10, 1938, applicant requests authority to use, temporarily, a four ride token ticket in lieu of metal tokens, such ticket to be punched when presented for fare and surrendered on the fourth ride. Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that the order portion of Decision No. 30849 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Market Street Railway Company is hereby authorized, on and after May 29, 1938, to charge the following fares, provided that it shall file a schedule containing said fares at least five days prior to making them effective and shall give five days' notice to the general public:

Fares in San Francisco, other than on  
interurban cars, with free transfers  
(Token fares shall be four for 25 cents)---7 cents cash fare  
or one token fare.

School children (San Francisco) with  
free transfers to other lines of the  
company for continuous travel in the  
same general direction-----16 rides for  
50 cents.

Sunday and Holiday Pass, for use in San Francisco -----	25 cents.
South San Francisco line -----	7 cents cash fare or one token fare.
San Mateo line -----	7 cents cash fare or one token fare where 5 cents is charged at present, and no change in the balance of present fare structure.

The form of "temporary four-ride token ticket" attached to the supplemental application of May 10, 1938, is hereby approved for use until September 30, 1938, unless otherwise hereafter ordered.

Applicant shall, prior to the use of metal tokens, submit to the Commission, for its approval, the size and design thereof.

At the time applicant files a schedule containing the fares authorized above, it shall also file appropriate rules and regulations which shall include an appropriate rule relating to the redemption of unused portions of the "temporary four-ride token ticket."

The Commission reserves the right to modify the above fare structure or to make such further orders in this proceeding as may be appropriate."

This second supplemental order shall be effective on the date hereof.
