The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway Route 106 (Road IV-CC-106-C) at grade across main line of Bay Point & Clayton Railroad Company near Clyde, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 14-3.0. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Bay Point & Clayton Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines, including maintenance of protection. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty-four (24) feet, and grades of approach not greater than six (6) per cent. Construction shall be by two A.R.A. Flashlight Signals.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
