ORIGINAL

By this application Edna A. Short, executrix of the estate of Ira N. Short, deceased, seeks authority to discontinue service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and property between Crescent Mills and Seneca and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No. 14338, on Application No. 10058.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority sought herein that owing to the discontinuance of the rail service by the Indian Valley Railroad between Paxton and Crescent Mills and the establishment of express offices at Crescent Mills and Green-ville that there is no further need of a transportation service as performed by applicant; that the United States Lail Contract which applicant held has been awarded to another person; that there is little or no property being transported to Seneca; and that only on rare occasions are passengers carried. There are, it is alleged, ample transportation facilities available over the route applicant seeks to abandon.

In view of the circumstances set forth herein, this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. Tho application will be granted ex parte.

ORDER

IT IS MEREBY ORDERED that Edna A. Short, executrix of the estate of Ira N. Short, deceased, be and she is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon the automotive service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and property between Crescent Mills and Seneca and intermediate points, and all tariffs and time schedulos therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 14338, dated December 8, 1924, on Application No. 10058, and all operative rights thereunder are revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
