

Decision No. 20881

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing the construction of a crossing at grade of the State highway and the tracks of Southern Pacific Railroad (San Ramon Branch), near Galindo, County of Contra Costa, State of California.) Application No. 21734.

O R D E R

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The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct State Highway (Road IV-CC-106-C) at grade across San Ramon Branch of Southern Pacific Company near Galindo Station, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B0-40.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than twenty four feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be provided by the installation of two A.R.A. Flashing Light signals at sole expense of applicant. The maintenance thereafter shall be borne by Southern Pacific Company.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
