amended to read as follows:

(1) Applicant shall discontinue said service within
a period not to exceed one hundred and twenty (120) days
from and after the effective date hereof and shall cancel
its tariff contemporaneously with such discontinuance of
service.

In all other respects Decision No. 30723 shall remain
unchanged and in full force and effect.
