ORDER

By Decision No. 20376, dated January 3rd, 1938, on Application No. 21559, Pacific Electric Railway Company was authorized to abandon all passenger rail service to the City of Whittier. As a condition to giving its consent to this abandonment, the City of Whittier asked that the Pacific Electric tracks on Philadelphia Street be removed. The instant application makes such a proposal.

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon and remove that portion of its tracks in Philadelphia Street in the City of Whittier, together with overhead and other appurtenances, as more definitely described in paragraph II of the application. Within thirty days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
