By this application Natalie Bacci, operating under the name and style of Cloverdale-Geysers Stage Line, seeks authority to temporarily suspend his automotive service for the transportation of passengers as a common carrier between Cloverdale and The Geysers and intermediate points as authorized by Decision No. 9597, dated October 6, 1921, on Application No. 7223.

Applicant seeks further authority for modification of his operating right for the transportation of property to limit shipments to not more than one hundred (100) pounds in weight.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority sought herein that the hotel at The Geysers was destroyed by fire and, consequently, passenger service to that resort is not required.

In view of the foregoing circumstances this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted ex parts.

O R D E R

IT IS HEAREN ORDERED that Natalie Bacci, operating under the name and style of Cloverdale-Geysers Stage Line, be and he is

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hereby authorized to temporarily suspend his automotive service for the transportation of passengers as a common carrier between Cloverdale and the Geysers and intermediate points as authorized by Decision No. 9597, dated October 6, 1921, on Application No. 7223, until December 1; 1933, provided that on or before that date he shall either resume service or relinquish his operating right, and provided further that he shall immediately file and make effective on five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to his tariff and a time schedule showing that service has been suspended as herein authorized.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said Natalie Bacci be and it is hereby amended to provide that,

> In the transportation of property no single shipment in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be transported.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
