By this application P. D. Johnson, operating under the name and style of Bakersfield Motor Line, seeks authority to discontinue his service as a common carrier for the transportation of property between San Francisco and Oakland, on the one hand, and Delano, Bakersfield, Magunden, Weed Patch and Arvin Districts, on the other hand, as authorized in Decision No. 23180, dated December 15, 1930, on Application No. 16807.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority sought herein that during the past four years he has been operating an "on call" service and during that period he has not received a call for his transportation service.

The allegation is substantiated by the annual report filed with the Commission showing therein that no service was performed during the year of 1937.

In view of the circumstances stated herein, this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and the application will be granted.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that P. D. Johnson, operating under the name and style of Bakersfield Motor Line, be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon his transportation service as a common carrier of property between San Francisco and Oakland, on the one hand, and Delano, Bakersfield, Magunden, Weed Patch and Arvin Districts, on the other hand, as authorized by Decision No. 23180, dated December 15, 1930, on Application No. 16807, and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 23180, dated December 15, 1930, on Application No. 16807, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.
