INTERIM ORDER ON REHEARING

By Decision No. 30561, dated January 31, 1938, in the above entitled application, E.V. Rideout was authorized to transfer his operative rights as a common carrier by vessel to Berkeley Transportation Co., a corporation. The latter company was authorized to consolidate such rights with those already owned by it and to operate a unified system. Upon petition of Southern Pacific Company, Pacific Motor Transport Company and The River Lines (The California Transportation Company and Sacramento and San Joaquin River Lines, Inc.) asserting that said decision enlarged the operative rights existent under separate ownership, the effective date of said decision was suspended and a rehearing was held at San Francisco on June 7, 1938.

At the rehearing all parties stipulated that authority to effect the transfer of operative rights might be granted by interim order, leaving for subsequent disposition the question of whether the proposed merger and consolidation of such operative rights should be permitted. Pursuant to said stipulation, and good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E.V. Rideout, an individual doing business as E.V. Rideout Co., be and he is hereby authorized to trans-

fer his operative rights as a common carrier by vessel to Berkeley Transportation Co., a corporation, and that, within thirty (30) days after such transfer, Berkeley Transportation Co. shall file with the Commission a true copy of the instrument of conveyance.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.

The foregoing opinion and order are hereby approved and ordered filed as the opinion and order of the Railroad Commission of the State of California.
