O P I N I O N

By this supplemental application Lassen National Park
(1)
Company, a corporation, successor to Lassen National Park Camp,
Ltd., operating as a common carrier for the automotive transporta-
tion of passengers, baggage and express between Redding and the
western gateway of Lassen Volcanic National Park and intermediate
points via Millville, Shingletown and Viola over State Highway
Route No. 44, seeks authority to amend its operating right for the
transportation of property on passenger carrying vehicles so that
no single shipment will be accepted and/or carried which would be
in excess of one hundred pounds.

Applicant alleges as justification for the authority
sought herein that it was not the intention of operator, when
operating right was granted, to transport any single shipment in
excess of one hundred pounds and further alleges that no single
shipment weighing one hundred pounds or over has been transported
since operating under the authority of Decision No. 28607, dated
March 2, 1938, on Application No. 20062.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted in Decision No. 28607, dated March 2, 1938, on Application No. 20062, to Lassen National Park Company be and it is hereby amended to provide that,

In the transportation of property no single shipment in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be transported.

Provided, further, that Lassen National Park Company shall immediately file and make effective on five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public a supplement to its tariff and a time schedule showing that service has been amended as herein authorized.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
