By this application E. A. Boehme, operating under the name and style of Marysville - Camptonville Stage Line, seeks authority to discontinue and abandon his service for the transportation of passengers and property between Marysville and Camptonville as authorized by Decision No. 22735, dated August 4, 1930, on Application No. 16716.

In justification for the authority sought herein, applicant alleges that there is not now, and has not been for some time past, sufficient passenger and freight business to pay operating expenses; that applicant's bus lost money in maintaining this service; and, that there is no longer any public need for applicant's service.

In view of the circumstances this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E. A. Boehme, operating under the name and style of Marysville - Camptonville Stage Line, be and

he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon his common carrier service for the transportation of passengers and property between Marysville and Camptonville as authorized by Decision No. 22735, on Application No. 16716, and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 22735, dated August 4, 1930, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be July 1, 1938.
