O P I N I O N

By this application J. S. Brown seeks authority to discontinue and abandon his service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and property between Redlands and Valley of the Falls and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No. 24906, dated October 5, 1931, on Application No. 17442.

In justification for the authority sought herein, applicant alleges that the business of practically his only four customers was destroyed by recent storm and flood, and that the balance of prospective users of his service would not return sufficient revenue to pay 10 per cent of operating costs thereby making it a financial impossibility to continue his service.

In view of the circumstances this appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The application will be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that J. S. Brown be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon his common carrier service

for the transportation of passengers and property between Redlands and the Valley of the Falls and intermediate points, as authorized by Decision No. 24906, dated October 5, 1931, on Application No. 17442, and all tariffs and time schedules therefor be and the same hereby are cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Decision No. 24906, dated October 5, 1931, on Application No. 17442, be and the same is hereby revoked and annulled.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
